TOOLS NEEDED: M6 ALLEN WRENCH

M4 ALLEN WRENCH

RUBBING ALCOHOL

LINT FREE TOWEL

THREAD LOCK COMPOUND

PLEASE READ THROUGH AND UNDERSTAND THESE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING.**USE A REMOVABLE THREAD LOCK ON ALL FASTENERS****INSTALLATION:**

1. REMOVE BOTH SIDE COVERS LOCATED NEXT TO THE PASSENGER PEGS/BOARDS FROM THE BIKE AND SET ASIDE.
2. USING A M6 ALLEN WRENCH REMOVE THE TWO BOLTS THAT HOLD THE SEAT TO THE BIKE. SEE FIG. 1.
3. REMOVE THE SEAT BY LIFTING THE FRONT AND PULLING FORWARD. SET ASIDE.
4. UNLOCK THE FUEL CAP ON THE TANK AND USING A M4 ALLEN WRENCH REMOVE THE THREE SCREW SHOWN IN FIG. 2. REMOVE THE FUEL CAP FROM BIKE.
5. CLEAN THE ENTIRE TANK AND REMOVE ANY DIRT AND BUGS IN THE AREA THE TUXEDO TIE IS GOING TO COVER. LET DRY.
6. USING RUBBING ALCOHOL AND A LINT FREE TOWEL CLEAN THE AREA ON THE BACK OF THE TANK SHOWN IN FIG. 3. LET DRY.
7. INSTALL THE TWO REAR PIECES OF HOOK TO THE BACK OF THE TANK AND PRESS THEM DOWN FIRMLY. SEE FIG. 3.
8. USING RUBBING ALCOHOL AND A LINT FREE TOWEL CLEAN THE TWO FLAT AREAS UNDER THE FRONT OF THE TANK NEXT TO THE AIR FILTER. SEE FIG. 4. LET DRY.
9. INSTALL THE TWO FRONT PIECES OF HOOK ON THE SURFACE YOU JUST CLEANED. PRESS THEM DOWN FIRMLY.
10. TAKE THE TUXEDO TIE AND INSERT THE FUEL CAP ASSEMBLY FROM THE TOP THROUGH THE LARGE ROUND HOLE. CENTER IN THE HOLE.
11. PLACE THE TUXEDO TIE AND FUEL CAP ON THE BIKE AND START THE THREADS ON THE THREE ALLEN SCREW YOU REMOVED IN STEP 2. DO NOT TIGHTEN.
12. ROTATE THE TUXEDO TIE ON THE TANK TO ALIGN THE CENTER OF THE TANK WITH THE CENTER OF THE TUXEDO TIE. TIGHTEN THE THREE ALLEN SCREWS.
13. STARING WITH THE BACK PULL EACH CORNER OF THE TUXEDO TIE TIGHT AND ATTACH THE LOOP ON THE TUXEDO TIE TO THE HOOK ON THE BIKE.
14. REINSTALL THE SEAT AND THE SIDE COVERS.
15. LET TAPE CURE FOR 24 HOURS BEFORE USING THE BIKE.
